



Vermont Emergency Management ICS/EOC Interface Training Program

Vermont Emergency Management will be conducting the ICS/EOC Interface Training Program for Emergency Managers.

This two session (3 hours per class) course provides an opportunity for participants to begin developing an effective interface between Incident Command and the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) for their community by applying Incident Command System (ICS) principles. The course reviews ICS and EOC responsibilities and functions and depends heavily on exercises and group discussions to identify interface issues and develop their solutions. As part of the course these concepts are then applied to exercise situations. Attendees will additionally begin developing a community specific ICS/EOC interface action plan for their region. This course is based on the G191 FEMA/Emergency Management Institute program and is also a Vermont EMD level II qualification course.

Municipal Emergency Management Directors and their associates from Fire, Rescue, Law Enforcement, Selectboards, and elsewhere are invited to attend and expand their knowledge of emergency management.

Since the two session classes are identical, you are welcome to attend class 1 at one location and class 2 at another site. The following schedule has been established.

- Jan. 23rd /30th - Hartford Fire Department
- Jan. 26th/Feb. 2nd – St. Albans VSP Barracks
- Feb. 2nd/9th - VY Training Center, Brattleboro
- Feb. 23rd/March 1st - Leahy Center, Rutland
- March 8th/15th - Williston Fire Department
